RECYCLE

Please do not bag recyclables, keep loose. Please empty all containers prior to recycling.



Clean Paper, Magazines, Newspaper, Junk Mail, Cardboard, Cereal Boxes



All Metal Beverage & Food Cans, Empty Aerosol Cans, Clean Aluminum Pans & Foil, Small Scrap Metal (Up To 20 Pounds)



Glass Bottles & Jars (Even broken)



Empty Plastic Bottles, Rigid Plastic Containers, Plastic To-Go Containers (#6 not accepted)



ORGANICS

Please use paper or ASTM D6400 rated compostable bags only to collect organics.



Grass, Weeds, Green Plants, Tree Limbs, Wood Chips, Dead Plants, Brush, Garden Trimmings, Leaves, Cut Flowers



Food Scraps, Including Egg Shells, Meat & Bones, Pizza Boxes, Carboard Egg Cartons, Coffee Grounds



Pizza Boxes, Cardboard Egg Cartons, Paper Coffee Filters, Any Food-Soiled Paper

Used Cooking Oil? Take to the West Sacramento Public Works Corporation Yard at 1951 South River Road (M-F, 8 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.)

Reminder: Treated wood not accepted in any curbside cart. Contact the Yolo County Landfill at 530-666-8729 for disposal options.

Proper waste sorting is now required. Residents may be charged for cart contamination. Trash cart contaminants includes food waste, landscape debris and wood waste, household hazardous waste and recyclables such as clean paper, cardboard, bottles and cans.

Proper waste sorting is now required. Contamination charges may apply. Recycling contaminants include plastic bags; other recyclable materials bagged in plastic bags (put recyclables in cart loose); soiled and/or wet paper and cardboard; recyclable containers that still contain liquids and/or solids; hazardous waste; and any item described as trash or organics in the above panels.

Proper waste sorting is now required. Cart contamination fees may apply. Organics cart contamination includes plastics of any kind except those specifically rated (ASTM D6400); Plastic coated paper, such as milk cartons or to-go cups; pet and human waste, kitty litter, glass, metal, rock, hazardous wastes and those items listed as trash or recycle.
